- Have you ever wanted to try autocross in a go-kart?
- Are you thinking about getting your kids involved in Solo/Autocross but don't want to make a big investment until you know they will like it?
- Are you thinking about going karting or getting your kids involved in karting but want to try it out in a low risk environment first?

Autocross is a timed (not wheel to wheel) automotive event on a course defined by traffic cones. It's a great environment to learn what it's like to drive a kart at the limit without the risk of going off track or contact with other karts or barriers. Whether you are interested in driving Karts in Solo or on the Wilson Circuit the rental program makes it easy and affordable to try out driving a kart.

What we provide:

- Comer C50 kid kart (for ages 5-7) or
- 4 cycle kart in choice of two chassis sizes for kids of all sizes from ages 8 to adult
- Helmet
- Neck brace
- Gloves
- Kart jacket

What you provide:

- Driver
- Long pants (preferably denim or other sturdy material)
- Closed toe shoes
- Minor waiver signed by both parents or guardians for drivers under 18
- \$70 entry fee that includes event entry and kart rental (\$60 for SCCA members)

Plan to arrive by 8:00 am (and stay until about 4:00 PM) on the day of the event so you can register, walk the course, and get fitted for a kart and safety equipment.
