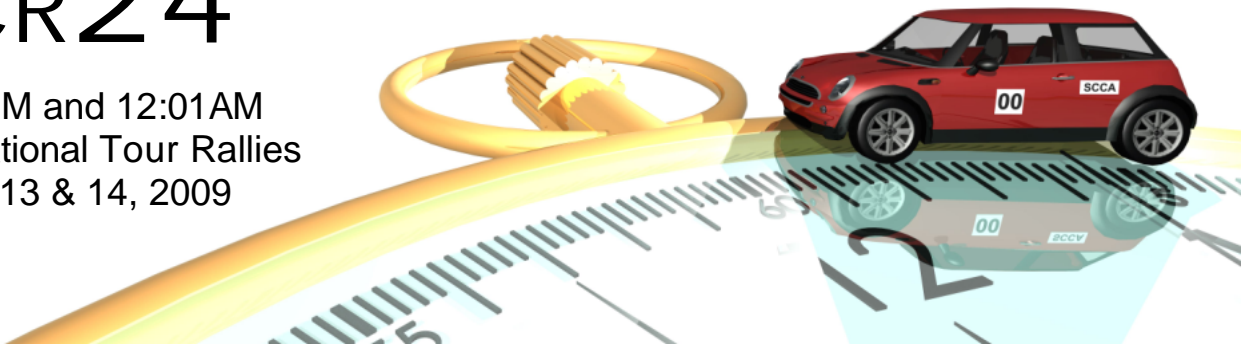

DESCRIPTION & PHILOSOPHY

The greatest motorsports events are those that continue for 24 hours. To capture this spirit, the SCR24 joins a pair of 12 hour road rallies. The SCR12:01PM begins the first car at 12:01 PM on June 13 and finishes before midnight, while the SCR12:01AM begins the first car at 12:01 AM on June 14 and finishes at noon. Contestants may enter either or both events.

The rally route is a loop of the city of Pittsburgh and southwestern Pennsylvania passing through Pennsylvania, Maryland, West Virginia and Ohio. The first event will run from Pittsburgh, Pa., to near Winchester, Va.; the second event returns to Pittsburgh.

The rallies use the SCCA **RoadRally** Rules for tour events. Instructions are in tulip format. Although under the speed limit, speeds are quick. There will be a minimum of 30 passage controls on each rally and no DIYCs (Do-It-Yourself-Controls).

There is a 20 minute break every two hours with one hour breaks for dinner and for breakfast, and 40 minute breaks before midnight and 3AM.

SCCA National Rally rules require two and only two contestants in the rally vehicle. Entrants' spouses and children traveling with them may elect to attend a family program on Saturday, June 13, 2009, at the Frick Art & Historical Center (www.thefrickpittsburgh.org) that will include family-friendly tours of the Frick mansion, the Car & Carriage Museum and the Frick Art Museum.

HEADQUARTERS

The block of 20-30 rooms will be held until May 22, 2009.

AWARDS

Entrants compete against contestants with similar equipment and experience. Any "car" awards will be given as duplicates to the driver and navigator. Three types of first place awards will be given:

- a) To the best finishing car in each SCCA equipment class;
- b) To the best finishing car in each SCCA equipment class with the best combined score from both events; and the
- c) AM/PM Team Award to the best placing team of two cars, one running only the PM event and the other running only the AM event. The cars will be rated by finishing position in any combination of SCCA equipment classes.

Also a MAX award will be given to the highest placing Class S team on either event who maxes at least 8 controls. A SUPERMAX award will be given to the highest placing Class S team on either event who maxes at least 16 controls.

Finally, to determine bragging rights for which SCCA Division has the strongest rally program and the best rallyists, awards will be given to the RoadRally Divisional Steward whose entrants' combined score is the best and whose entrants' combined score divided by their number of entries is the best.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is \$150 for one event, and \$300 for both events (including one meal per event). The fee for the program at The Frick will be less than \$10.00 per person, but does not include lunch. Contact the committee who will determine the exact composition of the program based on the planned attendance.
